Sub: - Admissions for the academic year 2019-20 in existing BHMS course with intake capacity of 60 seats at Mahalaxmi Homeopathic Medical College and Hospital and Research Centre, Maharashtra -reg.

Sir,

I am directed to refer to the provisions prescribed under Section 12C of the Homoeopathy Central Council Act, 1973 and regulations made thereunder. In order to verify the compliance of availability of standards by the College, the Board of Governors to CCH has conducted inspection of **Mahalaxmi Homeopathic Medical College and Hospital and Research Centre, Maharashtra**, on 16.05.2019 and furnished recommendation for not allowing admission in I- BHMS Course for the session 2019-20 with the intake capacity of 60 seats in existing UG (BHMS) course as only 11 full time are shown in acquaintance roll of which 01 with PhD in Biochemistry is not eligible, against requirement of 18 (for up to 2nd yr).

2. The college was granted an opportunity of hearing to present their case on 17.06.2019. The college appeared before the designated hearing committee on 17.06.2019 and submitted the oral and written submission.

3. After considering the provisions of section 12C (1) of Homoeopathy Central Council Act, 1973 and HCC(MSR) Regulations, 2013, recommendations of the Board of Governors to CCH and report of the designated hearing Committee of this Ministry, **permission of the Central Government is hereby granted to Mahalaxmi Homeopathic Medical College and Hospital and Research Centre, Maharashtra, for continuing admissions in I- BHMS course during the academic year 2019-20 with intake capacity of 60 seats.**

4. It is further informed that 15% of the permitted intake capacity of 60 UG seats shall be treated as all India quota. The counseling for seats under all India quota shall be conducted by the Central Government and counseling for the remaining 85% seats shall be conducted by the concerned State Government. If any seats are not filled up in the Central Counseling, the same shall be transferred to the concerned State Government to admit students as per their rules/ reservation policies/norms. **The permission to the college will stand withdrawn if the college fails to comply with the Central counseling for all India quota or the students admitted thereunder.**

 

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4. Admissions made in violation of the above conditions will be treated as invalid and action will be initiated under HCC Act & Regulations made thereunder. Discrepancies, if any, may be immediately brought to the notice of CCH and the Central Government.
5. The College shall submit an undertaking in the form of an affidavit duly notarized within one month from date of issue of this letter explaining the details of providing EPF and ESI facilities to the teaching, Non-teaching staff of the College/Hospitals and regularly paying the same as per the provisions of Employees' Provident Funds and Miscellaneous Provident Act, 1952 & ESI Act, 1948 and relevant Rules and Regulations.
6. Further, the College shall submit an undertaking in the form of an Affidavit duly notarized to get permanent registration of the Teachers,/ Hospital Clinical Staff/ Consultant in concerned State Boards/ Council where the college/ hospital is located or Central Registration of CCH by 31st December, 2019 as per the decision conveyed vide CCH's letter no. 15-1/2018-CCH(3)/18510-18768, dated 16th January, 2019 and decided by the High Court of Delhi in W.P. No. 2369 of 2019, which will be verified by the Council during next visitation while considering the matter for grant of permission for the A.Y. 2020-21.
7. The College has to comply with the full requirements of HCC (MSR) Regulations, 2013 by 31st December, 2019 for continuing admissions during the subsequent year. A copy of the compliance report shall be submitted by the college to CCH under intimation to this Ministry. Subsequently, CCH shall verify the compliance well in time for considering the admissions during the Academic Year 2020-21 and furnish the recommendation to the Central Government.
